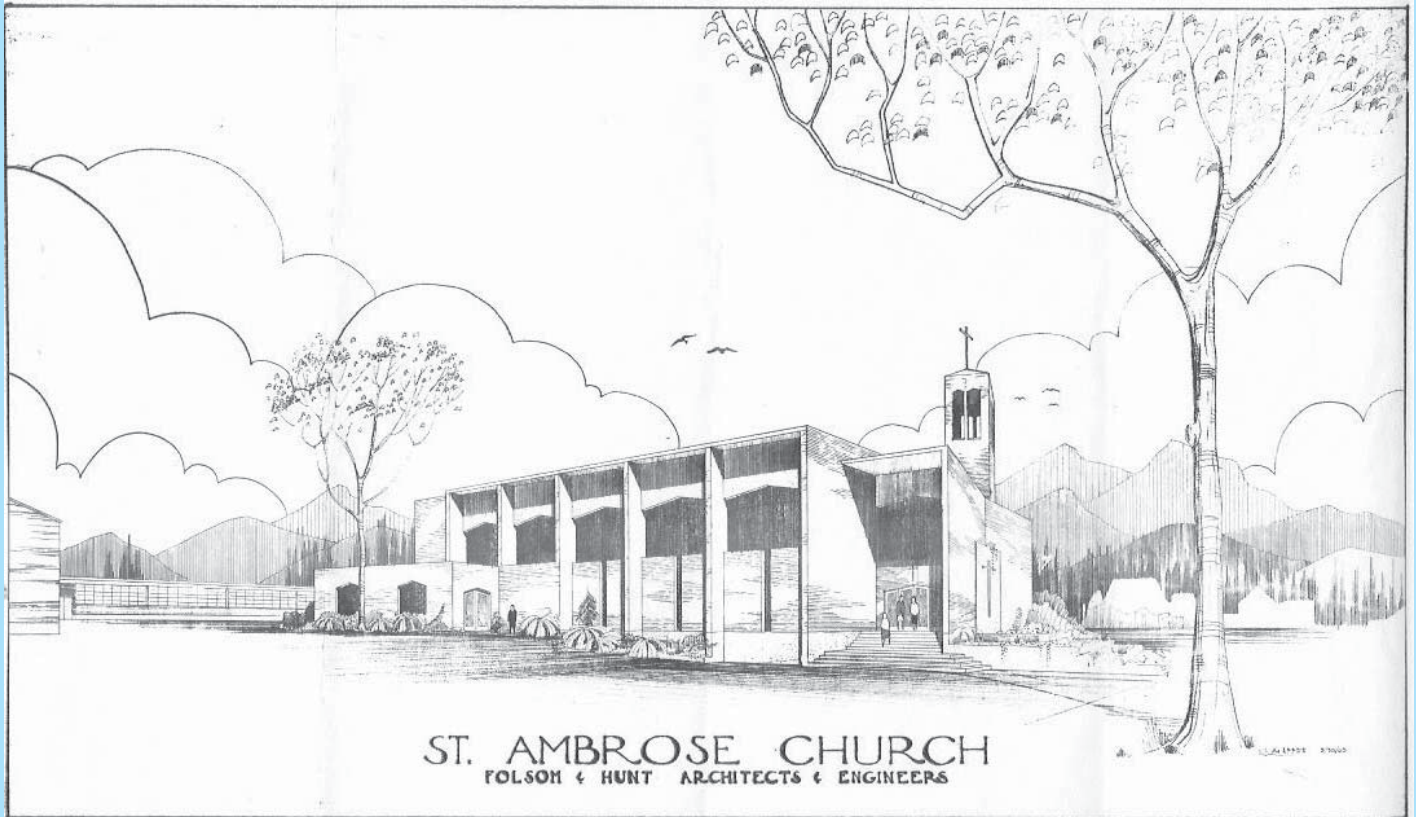

Peace and Justice Committee: Utah people of all faiths once again enthusiastically supported Salt Lake City's annual Adopt-a-Minefield fund-raiser. The event provided \$10,000 for land-mine removal. Six St. Ambrose parishioners were among those who planned and put on the dinner and silent auction. The United Nations trains, pays and supervises the de-miners and their work.

Parish Council Highlights

On Monday evening, April 28, the Parish Council met. The following are highlights of the meeting:

--Finance Report: The Parish is tracking a little above the budgeted income amount for the year. This is due in part to an excellent Easter collection. Our expenses are a little below what we anticipated. The financial situation of both the Parish and School looks good.

--DDD Report: We are about \$16,000 short of reaching the quota of \$175,000 set by the Diocese. To date 506 families have pledged \$159,000 to the drive.

--Anniversary Celebration: Everything is ready for the Anniversary celebration on Sunday, May 4th. The Parish Picnic on Sunday, June 8th, will continue the festivities. This fall a commemorative photo directory album will be produced with pictures of the parish families who are part of our community.

--Social Hall Remodel: We are still awaiting bids on the Social Hall remodel. Due to the scope of the project, work may not be beginning until Summer 2009.

--Confirmation Age Change: The Council considered a proposal introduced by Fr. Bill to change the Confirmation age from 9th grade to 8th grade beginning next year. After discussion, there was unanimous consensus that we should make the change to get our parish in sync with the neighboring parishes and to make it easier for our teenagers to complete Confirmation prior to going into high school.
