Summer Mass Schedule: On June 1st we will begin our new Summer Mass Schedule. Sunday Masses will be celebrated at **9:00 am and 11:00 am** on Sunday morning. We are making this change because of the fewer number of people attending Sunday Mass in the summer and to accommodate the vacation schedules of Father Gally and Father Bill. This schedule will be used from the weekend of June 1st through August 30th (Labor Day weekend). **In September we will return to the regular Mass Schedule of 8:00 am, 10:00 am and 12 noon.**
