Feast of the Dedication of the Basilica of St. John Lateran:

After Emperor Constantine officially ended the persecution of the Christian Church, he gave the Lateran Palace in Rome to the Church in 324. It was to be used as a place of worship. It was named for both St. John the Baptist and St. John the Evangelist, and was established as the mother church or cathedral of Rome. Popes resided next to the Church until the 14th century when St. Peter's was completed and the pope's residence was moved to the Vatican. Today St. John Lateran Basilica is still the cathedral of Rome and the church of the Bishop of Rome (the Pope). Today is a good opportunity to reflect upon the rich history of our Catholic faith dating back to the time of the apostles.
