More Graffiti Problems: Last Sunday we had another graffiti problem in the Men's Restroom in the Church. Someone took tacks off the bulletin board from the southeast Church entrance and scratched obscenities in the bathroom door. (Three tacks were actually left on the sink in the bathroom.) This vandalism will cost many hours of our maintenance director's time to sand and refinish the door. This is not the first time we have experienced this kind of vandalism and graffiti in the Men's Restroom but it clearly took some thought and planning for the perpetrator to remove tacks from the bulletin board and take them into the restroom. We believe that it happened sometime between 9 am and 12 noon—probably during the 10 am Mass. We are asking parents and all adults to monitor the children and teenagers more closely to avoid a repeat of this incident. If this continues, it may be necessary to put video surveillance equipment in the hall so we can determine who is disrespecting and defacing Church property. Parents and adults, thank you for your cooperation. If you use any restrooms in the Church or social hall and notice graffiti or vandalism, please report it immediately to one of the priests or deacons so we can address it when it happens.

**Reverend Thomas Joseph Kaiser**



Reverend Thomas Joseph Kaiser, Priest of the Diocese of Salt Lake City 1923 ~ 2008. Reverend Thomas Joseph Kaiser died at Christus St. Joseph Villa on Saturday evening, April 5, 2008, of age related causes. He was 84 years of age. Thomas Kaiser was born July 4, 1923, in Minneapolis, Minnesota, to Walter and Erma Maas Kaiser, both deceased. He attended

Saint Paul Seminary in Saint Paul, Minnesota, and was ordained a priest on June 4, 1949, for the Catholic Diocese of Salt Lake City. Father Kaiser was always a parish priest who cared in a special way for the poor and those whose lives were on the fringes of society. He lived simply, with few material possessions. He had a profound faith that reflected his devotion to the Divine Mercy of Jesus and to the Blessed Virgin Mary. He was much admired by his many faithful friends. During his early years of priestly ministry he served at Our Lady of Lourdes and Saint Ann Parishes in Salt Lake City. In 1955, he established Saint Pius X Parish, in Moab, and was its first pastor. Subsequently, he was pastor of Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish, Salt Lake City, Our Lady of Lourdes Parish, in Magna, Saint Joseph Parish, in Ogden, and Good Shepherd Parish, in East Carbon City. **He served as Associate Pastor at St. Ambrose Parish from 1989-1990.** During retirement he assisted at Saint Vincent de Paul Parish, in Salt Lake City, and frequently ministered to young people at the Youth Detention Center. Father Kaiser is survived by all of his siblings. He is also survived by nieces and nephews who were very fond of Father Tom. His Funeral Mass was celebrated on Wednesday, April 9, 2008, at the Cathedral of the Madeleine. Committal was at Mount Calvary Catholic Cemetery
