Message from Bishop Wester: The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops and I support comprehensive immigration reform at the federal level rather than fragmented legislation passed by the states. I am concerned that the upcoming implementation of the new Utah immigration laws may increase the anxiety and confusion of many of our parishioners.

I have asked Dee Rowland, our diocesan Government Liaison, to make available information on the implications of the new Utah laws as well as background materials on Catholic teachings on immigration. This information is available at www.dioslc.org, Ministries, Programs, and Services, under Government and Community Relations.

Please continue to pray for all those suffering from unjust laws and remember that regardless of their legal status, migrants, like all persons, possess inherent human dignity which should be respected.

Oblates Leaving Salt Lake City: The Diocese has announced that the Oblates of St. Francis de Sales of the Toledo-Detroit Province will be leaving the Diocese of Salt Lake City after this academic year. Most of our parishioners know the Oblates if they attended Judge High School. (*Father Jim Mc Hugh, who is an Oblate priest, is a familiar figure at St. Ambrose because he celebrates many marriages and baptisms for Judge graduates.*) The Oblates have worked as administrators and teachers at Judge since 1961. They have also served as Pastors in Moab, Price, Copperton and Bountiful at various times. Our prayers and thanks are with the Oblates for their many years of service in our Diocese.
