**Pastor Change:** Effective on August 1, 2009, Father Bill Wheaton will become the new Pastor of St. Pius X Parish in Moab, Utah and St. Joseph Parish in Monticello. Fr. Father Andrew, Pastor of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish in Magna, has been named as the new Pastor of St. Ambrose.
